Book your FREE NHS Health Check today with Health Checks Oxfordshire

If you are aged 40-74 years and live in Oxfordshire, you could be eligible for a FREE NHS Health Check with Health Checks Oxfordshire.

The new service launched earlier this year to assist GP practices in catching up with Health Checks that were missed during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The health check takes 30-45 to complete and will give you a snapshot of what is going on inside your body to help you tackle health problems before they become a concern. The check aims to reduce your risk developing heart disease, stroke, type 2 diabetes, kidney disease and certain types of dementia and achieves this by assessing the risk factors. Your expert health advisor will ask a number of questions relating to your health, measure your height and weight, take your blood pressure and a quick and easy finger prick blood sample.

At the end of a health check, you'll be given a personalised report outlining your results to take away from the appointment. Depending on your results, you'll be receive advice on how to lower your risk with lifestyle changes.

We work with a <u>number of local</u> partners to ensure that you have access to the support you need following your health check. Whether you need help to quit smoking, lose some weight or cut down on your alcohol intake – we'll signpost you to free and local services that can help you achieve these goals.


